## **GUIDANCE SHEET**

This sheet is to log the different sections of the village who attend a social norm or empower community activity organized by TP Girls. Thus, SM will ensure that they get an estimate of the number of adolescent girls, adolescent boys, adult community members and religious leaders/influential people who are attending the community activity. The SMs will do a headcount at the start of the activity to find out how many of those present are the TP group members and non-group members. The SM may ask any other staff as well if they recognize mothers or fathers from the Mothers' and Fathers' groups, or religious leaders, government officials, or school officials who have participated in the sessions for those groups. The numbers can be an estimate as it can be difficult to get exact numbers during a big event. These numbers should be entered in the sheet above, corresponding to each of these sections of the community people.

In the Month 7 of the project, the boys' and parents' activist groups will be formed. After that, a new sheet will be provided which will also have space to count the number of boys and parents activist group members who are present in the community event.
